Advanced Placement courses at Bunnell High School are for students who are seeking the challenge of taking a college-level course and wish to earn college credit while still in high school. Because AP coursework is the most rigorous offered at Bunnell High School, students will be recommended into the Advanced Placement program based on teacher recommendations, grades earned in previously taken Honors level courses, and other criteria as outlined in the Program of Studies. Any student who is not recommended for an AP Course they wish to enroll in must complete an Override form. Students enrolling in AP courses agree to make the commitment to meet the expectations noted below.

Student Expectations

- Advanced Placement classes require a significant time commitment outside of school, as the workload for an AP class is intended to be comparable to a college course. Students who wish to take multiple AP classes should consider the time needed to do the work for each of the classes with respect to the time needed to pursue other after-school interests.
- All AP Courses have Summer Assignments. Completion of Summer Assignments is crucial to success in AP classes. Students are expected to adhere to teacher timelines for submission of coursework during the summer. Summer Assignments are posted on the Bunnell High School Website.
- Students are expected to take the AP exam for each course in which they are enrolled. The cost for each AP exam will be approximately \$ 98.00. Exam Registration deadline in November 1, 2020. There will be a \$ 40.00 per exam late registration fee. There will also be a \$40.00 per exam cancellation fee. Students who receive free or reduced lunch are exempt from regular deadline registration fees. They are not exempt from late/cancellation fees.
