

Bylaws of the Board

Vote Recording

All votes shall be via voice, yea, and nay, or abstention, except as noted below.

The affirmative vote of a majority of all the members of the Board present, duly recorded showing how each member voted shall be required in order to take action of the following subjects:

1. Electing Officers
2. Adoption of Textbooks
3. Appointing or dismissing Superintendent, teachers or any other school employees.
4. Any agenda item requiring expenditures or receipt of monies.
5. Acceptance of financial reports.
