

STRATFORD PUBLIC SCHOOLS REOPENING PLAN FOR 2020-2021

The Reopening Plan for 2020-2021 for Stratford Public Schools is made up of three reopening scenarios (tiers). The district will be prepared to transition from one tier level to another as it becomes necessary to avoid spread risk of the COVID-19 virus. All tier levels will include the reinforcement of practicing healthy hygiene and social distancing protocols (at all times). For Tier 1 and Tier 2, staff and students will be required to wear a mask. Breakfasts and lunches will be “grab & go” eating in the classrooms at elementary and middle school level. High school students will be allowed additional spaces for eating. Enhanced sanitization will take place in buildings, classrooms and on buses on a regular basis.

Note: The definition of Cohort will vary depending on Tier level. In all Students In-Person, Cohort will be more about social distancing. In Tier 2 – Cohorts will be in their classroom (at the elementary level). At the middle school level, Cohort will be teams. Cohort groups are more challenging at the high school level.

- **Tier 1:** In person learning, will run Monday – Friday for the regular school day. More information will become available as to scheduling, etc.
- **Tier 2:** Cohort groups will represent 50 % of the student population alternating “in person” and “distance” learning.
- **Tier 3:** All Students will be participating in Distance/Remote learning.

Parents’ Choice for Distance/Remote Learning: Parents will have the choice to have their child remain home and engage in distance learning. Teachers will be utilizing Google Classroom as well as “live” streaming. Meals will be provided to children engaged in distance learning and may be picked up at the schools during a designated timeslot.
