Spanish 1b

Spanish 1b is a continuation of language learning from 7th grade focused on communicative language acquisition through listening, reading, speaking, and writing in the target language. Students will synthesize previously studied concepts to expand and reinforce real-world applications of language study as well as explore various cultural traditions. Throughout the course, students will engage in activities to study the community and members of the community, the geography and culture of the Spanish-speaking world, and the enhanced opportunities for travel language study provides. These skills are taught via scaffolding curriculum that capitalizes on sharpening previously studied concepts while introducing new skills to expand current language capacities.

Let's Travel!	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Utilize vocabulary to ask for and give information and to talk about a trip ● Engage in basic conversations to remind and reassure someone; to express hopes and wishes and to speak about the past in the preterite ● Form and utilize the preterite of verbs ending in -car, -gar, and -zar ● Use hacer in the preterite ● Use the informal commands of verbs with spelling changes and irregular forms ● Correctly place direct object pronouns ● Use verbs followed by infinitives
