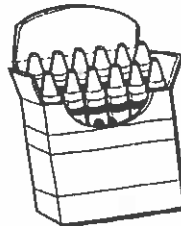

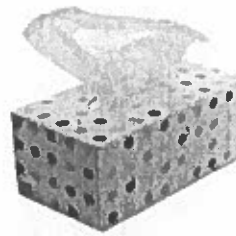

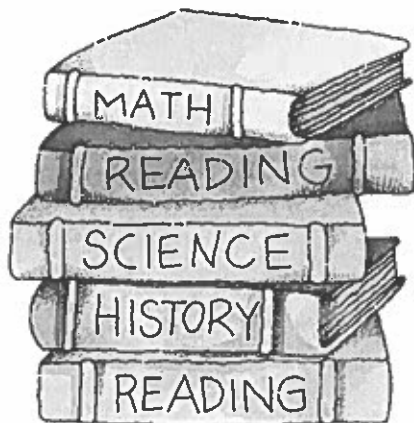


These are the supplies that are ***suggested*** for each student to have for this year:

General Supplies:

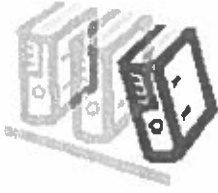
- 5 Black and White Composition Notebooks- Reading, Math, Writing, Science and Social Studies
