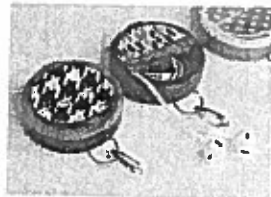

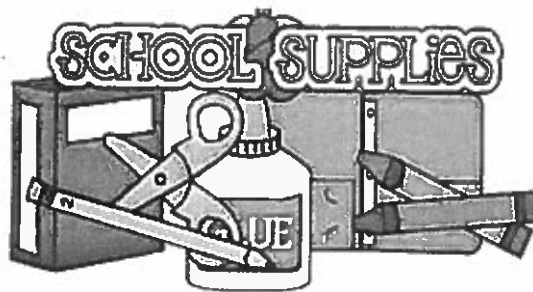

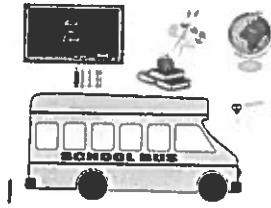

Your child will be seated at tables/desk groups and all pencils and other materials will be stored in a caddy on the table for all to share. Please do not bring in pencil cases. Your child should feel free to bring a refillable water bottle so they can stay hydrated.

We recommend that all children have a book for recreational reading in school each day. They should bring a library book or a book of their own that is appropriate to their reading capabilities. We each have classroom libraries for your child to peruse as well.

All children should practice multiplication and division facts along with ST Math. They should also read daily throughout the summer and remember to return their summer reading calendars at the start of the school year.
