Friday:

1. Cohort B is scheduled to come to school and should arrive no earlier than 7:20 am. This is being done in an effort to help prevent students from congregating; please adhere to this.
2. All students should report to period one. We will have staff to help any child who may need help finding their class. Schedules will be passed out to all students at this time.
3. Students should exit the building the same way they enter in the morning.

Important daily reminders:

When in school, students will wear their district issued masks at all times, except while eating. Students who do not comply with this expectation will be sent home. Mask breaks and opportunities for fresh air will be provided during the day. Cohort A received their masks today and Cohort B will receive them Friday. Masks must also be worn on the school bus.

All students who are being dropped off must have their ride enter the King Street campus via King Street or California Street.

All student drivers should enter the North Parade Campus and park in their assigned spot. If you did not secure a parking spot, please do not drive to school as there will be no parking.

Live streaming of classes will begin for all students on Monday, September 14th. Starting on that date, all students, while home, are expected to be logged into their live classrooms. This includes Wednesdays.
