- Juniors **only** will report to BHS or SHS as appropriate for testing from 7:30-10:30am.
- Students who do not finish the assessment will have the opportunity to complete it on another day.
- All students in grades 9, 10, and 12 will be given assignments to complete independently at home; teachers will do their best to respond to questions when they are not proctoring the NGSS.
- Students who would normally have transportation (living over 2 miles away from the school) will continue to have it for this testing day provided they indicate this need on the Google Form for the NGSS.
- Breakfast and lunch will be provided. Students will indicate their lunch preference on Google Form for the NGSS.
- If students will be picked up at the end of the day instead of taking school transportation home, they will indicate this on Google Form for the NGSS.
