Stratford Public Schools are offering current sophomores and juniors the opportunity to practice a full-length PSAT on October 13, 2021. Ninth graders will have the opportunity to practice using an online test on Tuesday, November 16, 2021.

Wednesday, October 13, 2021—Sophomores and Juniors Only in School

- Sophomores and Juniors will take the PSAT/NMSQT in a paper/pencil format.
- Sophomores and Juniors will report to BHS, SHS, or ALPHA as appropriate for testing from 7:30-Noon.
- Students who test past Noon will have transportation home if they normally would have transportation.
- All students in grades 9 and 12 will be given assignments via Google Classroom to complete independently at home.
- Lunch will be provided as students leave in a grab and go format.
- If students will be picked up at the end of the day instead of taking school transportation home, they will indicate this on the Google Form for the PSAT.
- Students in STEPS, Bridges, and SAILS can attend school regardless of grade level.

Tuesday, November 16, 2021—All Students in School—9th Graders Only Testing

- All students will report to school.
- All 9th graders must have their Chromebooks for testing.
- 9th graders will take the PSAT in a separate section of each school.
