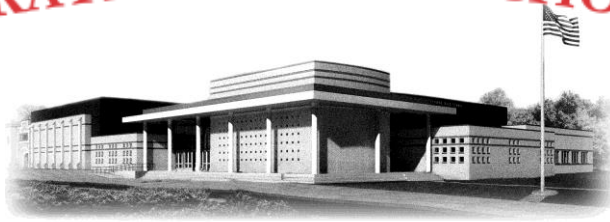

So today marks the start of the third week of the 2020-2021 school year. I would like to thank all of you for your feedback, support, and suggestions during this unique time. We will continue to grow and learn together through this process.

As always, we have a few reminders for you to help ensure we are all operating under the same guidelines.

1. Student Attendance:

1. We understand that students do become ill (non Covid related) and need to stay home. The hybrid learning model allows them to participate from home and stay current in all of their classes, which is great. However, we still need to know that they will not be present in school for the day. Please call your child out sick (just like you always have) but include in that call that they will be accessing their learning remotely that day so our daily attendance can be recorded accurately. 2. Cohort/Distance Learning

1. If your child is participating in school via Distance Learning and you would like them to return to school for their cohort, please call the school to arrange for this. We need 1 week's notice to make the change.

3. Food Service:

1. Just to clarify our student lunch choice surveys, they are sent directly to our students through their district issued email address. They can respond prior to returning to school with their cohort. These are sent out on Friday afternoons for Cohort A and Tuesday afternoons for Cohort B.
2. Please continue to fill out any free/reduced lunch forms and return them to the main office at SHS. For your convenience we have included a copy of those forms in this email.

Please remember that student attendance in all classes is required for accurate record keeping. Attendance will be taken for students both in school and for those who attend class virtually.
