To Stratford High School Parents/Guardians:

Listed below is Stratford High School's final examination schedule for underclassmen. For students who normally ride the bus, morning pick up will be at the regular time; departure time will be 11:15 AM. On Wednesday, June 12<sup>th</sup> the morning pickup will be at the regular time; departure time will be 9:20 AM.

Students **do not** take an examination in study hall, or resource. Physical education exams will be given during their regular scheduled class the week prior due to graduation set up. Students who have no first examination but do have a second examination may arrive at school at 9:30 AM. If bus transportation is required, students may come to school at the regular time and study in the cafeteria.

If a student misses an examination, a parent **must** notify their administrator. A note from a doctor is required for this to be an excused absence. Upon a student's return to school for an excused absence, that student must contact the teacher and make arrangements for the make-up examination. Failure to contact a teacher prior to Wednesday, June 12<sup>th</sup> to reschedule a make-up examination will result in a failing semester examination grade. If a student does not take their final examination, they are not eligible for summer school.

The last day of school is **Thursday, June 13<sup>th</sup>**. This is a scheduled half day with an 11:15 AM dismissal. Students will be provided the opportunity to review their exams, complete locker cleanup, and finalize any accounting issues with their teachers and/or office during that time.
