

## **Everything the 7th Grader Needs to Succeed At Wooster**

**Required Materials:** this list gets our 7th graders started for their new adventure at Wooster. Once they have visited all their classes the first week of school, they will MOST likely be given lists of other supplies needed in their specific core classes.

- **ONE extra-large Zip-Up Binder:** Those binders with a strap are best.
- **Four 2-Pocket Folders:** (with holes) One folder for each subject area. The folders will also be used as dividers between each subject area in your binder.
- **2-3 Packs of Loose Leaf Filler Paper:** This is used for notes in each subject area and for completing homework on. Bring in ONE pack to school on the day you are setting up your binder with your teachers. *You will need to replenish your paper as the year progresses.*
- **3-4 Bound Composition Notebooks (NOT SPIRAL NOTEBOOKS!):** These are specifically for Science, ELA, and World Geography. *For Math ONLY, the notebook can be a composition notebook OR a spiral notebook.*
- **ONE pencil pouch:** To hold pens, pencils, calculator, highlighters, etc. This will be kept in your zip-up binder.
- **LOTS of pencils and pens (black or blue ONLY)** - Students are NOT allowed to use colored or pastel pens on their assignments – only black or blue.
- **ONE highlighter** (to be placed in pencil pouch)
- **ONE calculator** (to be placed in pencil pouch) Not all teachers allow you to use your phone calculator, so it is wise to have a plain calculator handy.
- **ONE box of tissues** (These are to be **given to your homeroom teacher** the first week of school for student use in all our classrooms throughout the year.)

### **Suggested Materials to Have at Home to Use:**

- A ruler (with both inches and centimeters)
- Colored pencils and/or crayons

**Use of a computer/internet** – This is very important, because most teachers have students complete assignments and projects on the computer, along with utilizing Google Classroom. **The daily use of Google Classroom and the internet is required in many classes.**

**REMINDER:** Students are responsible for being prepared DAILY with the above supplies for EVERY class, ESPECIALLY A PEN OR PENCIL. If and when any of the above materials are lost, broken, or have run-out at any point throughout the year, they will need to be replaced. Teachers are NOT responsible for supplying students with pens, pencils, paper, etc.
